Dr. R. Chaussinand, formerly at the Pasteur Institute in French Indo China, has been appointed director of the Leprosy Service of the Pasteur Institute in Paris, a position formerly held by the late Dr. Marchoux.

DR. ERNEST MUIR has resigned, as of April 1, 1947, his post as Medical Secretary of the British Empire Leprosy Relief Association. He has been appointed as one of the Medical Advisers to the Association. He has been succeeded as Medical Secretary by DR. Gordon Ryrie, who for many years was the Medical Superintendent of the Sungei Buloh Leprosy Settlement in Malaya.

Dr. Chas. M. Ross is at present carrying out a survey of leprosy in the British colony of Gambia, West Africa, with the help of local staff. Little has been done for the control of leprosy in Gambia, but it is hoped that, in the light of the evidence of this survey, permanent methods of control may be established.
