A CORRECTION

TO THE EDITOR:

There is a rather important error in the article by Dr. Lowe and myself in THE JOURNAL, Vol. 17, No. 3. This error occurs on Page 194, paragraph 4, which reads: "He has been able to

demonstrate the spectrum of methemoglobin or methemalbumin in sulfone-treated cases." This is incorrect from two points of view. In the first place, it reads as though methemoglobin and methemalbumin are the same. In the second place, I have *never* been able to demonstrate the spectrum of methemoglobin, but the spectrum of methemalbumin is frequently observable in cases undergoing diaminodiphenyl sulfone (DDS) therapy with a dose of 0.3 gm. daily.

I hope that you can publish a correction of this error, because this point of finding methemalbumin in the plasma of cases on diaminodiphenyl sulfone is an important one from a biochemical point of view.

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
