AVAILABILITY OF "AVLOSULFON"

TO THE EDITOR:

I was interested to see, in a recent editorial [THE JOURNAL 19 (1951) 344-349] the statement that DDS is not as readily available as might be expected, and I thought that as a matter of interest you may care to know what the situation is as far as we are concerned.

As you know, we market DDS under the trade mark name of "Avlosulfon," and we operate actively in practically every country where there is leprosy. I think, therefore, that it is true to say that subject to temporary difficulties in the supply position which have arisen from time to time, any leprosarium that wants DDS can get it without very much trouble.
