NEED OF LITERATURE IN RUSSIA

To the Editor:

Medical research workers in Russia are greatly handicapped by the difficulty of obtaining literature from other parts of the world. Since my return from the leprosy asylum in Vladivostok I have maintained interest in leprosy work, and at present am engaged in studying the problems of early diagnosis, as well as of treatment. However, though some of my friends have kindly supplied me with reprints of their articles, I have not been able to keep in touch with the work in many places, especially North and South America and India. It would be appreciated if this note could be brought to the attention of the readers of the INTERNATIONAL JOURNAL, in the hope that they will be so good as to send us reprints of their reports.

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
