Not adjusted, however, for differences in number of subscriptions between 1933 and 1973. With printing costs adjusted to about the 1933 subscription level the 1973 costs would be approximately \$42,000 = 1933, \$12,245 equivalent. Subscriptions should be about \$32 (1973 dollars) to keep on same relative level relating to production costs and dollar value as compared with 1933.
